

Grant Process



Start with an Idea

Go to our website to review grants previously funded to spark some ideas or to see whether your idea has been done before. You do not need to run a pilot program before approaching the BEF for support. Discuss your idea with a Board member or email any questions to us for any clarification needed.

Complete the Application

Complete the BEF grant application by filling out all requested information. Be sure to ask any Board member questions about anything that may be unclear or difficult to answer. We are happy to help! Be sure to include a detailed budget.

Board Review

Typically, the Board will review your application within 30 days. You may be asked to attend a Board meeting to present your application and answer questions. You will be notified by a Board member of the funding decision as soon as possible.

Run Your Program

If approved, get ready to run your proposed program! You will be appointed a primary contact from the BEF Board who will help you through the process of securing funds and providing any necessary progress updates.



Grant ideas may be submitted at any time and are reviewed on a rolling basis.
